Course Description

The Level 1 Award in Health and Safety at Work (QCF) is a knowledge-based qualification for individuals who wish to gain formal recognition of their knowledge and understanding of health and safety in the workplace. As it is knowledge-based, there is no requirement for learners to have access to a workplace. By completing the single mandatory unit, all learners will cover the importance of health, safety and welfare standards, how hazards and risks are controlled, the main causes and effects of poor health and safety and how health and safety information is communicated in the context of the workplace.

Who should attend?

There are no formal entry requirements. However, learners should be able to work at level 1 or above and be proficient in the use of English language.
