Course Description

The Level 2 Award in Fire Safety Principles (QCF) is a qualification aimed at individuals who intend to have responsibility for fire safety in the workplace. It provides learners with formal recognition of their knowledge and understanding of fire safety and is suitable for Fire Warden or Fire Marshall roles, as well as Managers, Supervisors and Team Leaders. The qualification is generic; therefore it is applicable to a variety of working environments.

Who should attend?

There are no formal entry requirements. However, learners should be able to work at level 1 or above and be proficient in the use of English Language.
