Level 3 Award in Education and Training



The Level 3 Award in Education and Training provides an introduction to teaching. It can meet the needs of a range of trainee teachers, such as:

- Individuals not currently teaching or training achievement of the gualification does not require practice other than microteaching,
- Individuals currently teaching and training, including those who have just begun teaching and training – although the qualification does not require practice other than microteaching (unless units from the learning and development suite of qualifications are selected),
- Individuals currently working as assessors who wish to achieve a qualification that provides an introduction to teaching.

This qualification replaces the Level 3 Award in Preparing to Teach in the Lifelong Learning Sector (QCF).

Who should attend?

All trainee teachers joining this qualification programme should undertake an initial assessment of skills in English, mathematics and ICT. They should record their development needs and, where applicable, agree an action plan to address them.
